On This Day...

IEEE pays tribute to the great civil engineer John Edgar Thomson who passed on this day in 1874. Thomson was responsible for organizing a network of railroads that increased efficiency in transportation from Philadelphia to as far west as Chicago and as south as Norfolk, VA, USA.

The Edison Storage Battery Company was founded on 27 May 1901. Edison wanted to increase the performance of the common lead cell battery, but his main reason behind founding the company was to conceive a feasible battery that could power an automobile. His great mind was one of those that founded the American Institute of Electrical Engineers (AIEE), which eventually merged with the Institute of Radio Engineers (IRE) to become IEEE.

Lastly, IEEE would like to honor the late Nobel Prize winner Ernst August Friedrich Ruska who died on 27 May 1988. Ernst split the Nobel Prize for Physics with Heinrich Rohrer and Gerd Binnig in 1986 for his invention, the electron microscope.
