WHAT IS THE CERN ENTREPRENEURSHIP STUDENT PROGRAMME?

The CERN Entrepreneurship Student Programme (CESP) is a five-week summer programme for teams of Master's level students interested in technology entrepreneurship. Throughout the programme, the participating teams will work with CERN experts in machine learning to develop a plan on how to build and grow their new ventures.

WHO CAN APPLY?

You can apply as a team of 2-4 Master's level students or as an individual. You do not need to have an incorporated start-up, but you need to have an idea of your problem, solution, market and team. Additionally, you must benefit from CERN's expertise in machine learning or related fields.

EXPLORE

Introduction to CERN and its expertise in machine learning through interaction with experts, with emphasis on the added value from CERN's expertise to the participating teams' start-up ideas.

EVALUATE

Market evaluation of identified problem and solution. Develop a plan on how to build and grow your new venture.

EXPLOIT

Start building your new venture with assistance from CERN experts and experienced entrepreneurs, getting ready to apply for incubators or accelerators.
